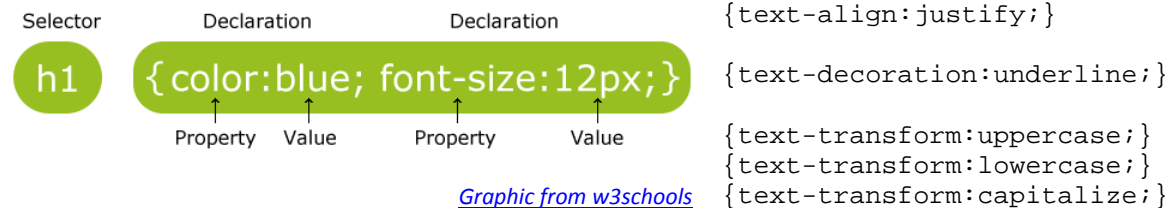

## CSS SYNTAX



## CSS SELECTORS

Selectors tell CSS WHAT you want to style. It can be:

- An HTML element. For example: `p {}` or `body {}` or `h2 {}`
- The Class selector which starts with a “.” (period). For example to select `<p class="style1">` the selector would be `.style1`
- The ID selector which starts with a “#” (number sign). For example to select `<p id="style1">` the selector would be `#style1`

Note: each “class” can be used many times in a document while each “ID” should only be used once.

## SOME STYLE DECLARATIONS

Declarations tell CSS HOW you want to style.

### FOREGROUND / FONT COLOR

### FONTS

{font-family: "Times New Roman", Times, serif;}
```

{font-family: Arial, Helvetica, sans-serif;}

```
{font-size: 40px;}
```

```
{font-weight: bold;}
```

### TEXT

```
{text-align: center;}
```

```
{text-align: right;}
